SUBJECT: MARINA OPERATIONS QUARTERLY ACTIVITY REPORT

Marina operations activity during 3rd quarter of 2018:

- <u>Launch</u> When comparing 3rd quarter 2017 to 3rd quarter 2018, the number of round-trip launches were up by 4% or 67 more roundtrip launches. Fishing opportunities in Area 9 and Area 10 were very good this year.
- <u>Guest Moorage</u> We had visits from 2020 boats that stayed for a total of 3024 nights. Also, we opened up the guest moorage areas for group reservations due to early reports that fishing activity and opportunity would be limited. 6 groups made up of 26 boats and staying a total of 46 nights booked guest moorage during 3rd quarter 2018.
- <u>Fuel Dock</u> prices were up by 18% on unleaded and up by 9% on diesel at 3rd quarter end 2018 compared to 3rd quarter end 2017. Total gallons pumped increased by 7% or 13,832 more than in 3rd quarter 2017. Gasoline decreased by 1,272 gallons (-1%) and diesel increased by 15,104 gallons.
- <u>Travelift & Boatyard</u> days are up by 184 days or 39% in 3rd quarter 2018 compared to 3rd quarter 2017. Sling time pressure wash numbers remained the same as 3rd quarter 2017. Sling time with no wash was down by 20% or 8 boats compared to 3rd quarter 2017.

Moorage and Dry Storage:

- In water moorage terminations decreased from 40 in 3rd quarter 2017 to 34 in 3rd quarter 2018. Turnover ratio decreased from 6.04% in 3rd quarter 2017 to 5.13% in 3rd quarter 2018.
- Waitlist increased from 125 names on the list at the end of 3rd quarter 2017 to 134 at the end of 3rd quarter 2018.

- In dry storage terminations decreased from 33 in 3rd quarter 2017 to 20 in 3rd quarter 2018. Turnover ratio decreased from 14.2% in 3rd quarter 2017 to 8.6% in 3rd quarter 2018.
- New dock protocols, new hours, new amenities, and new "pay-per-move" offered in Dry storage this year.
 - o New dock protocols received very positive feedback from dry storage customers
 - O Dry Storage began opening at 5am for King season this year. The season went from July 16th to August 16th. Total moves for the 30-day season was 2533 moves. Between the hours of 5am and 7am during the King season a total of 452 moves were made, that is 18% of the total moves. 233 moves from 5am to 6am. 219 moves from 6am to 7am. On average this works out to 6 to 7 moves per hour between 5am & 7am.
 - O Water, lights, and a gate were installed on A-dock per customer requests. This also received positive feedback from customers.
 - o Pay-per-move was introduced for the 21'11" and under category of boats. There was one sign-up for this during 3rd quarter.
 - O Total boat handling moves by the forklifts for this quarter was 6449. This is about 19% more than 3rd quarter 2017.
